

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP
Held Monday, July 15, 2024

The President of the Monroe Township Trustees, Joe Robertson, called the meeting to order on Monday, July 15, 2024 5:30pm at the township complex.

The fiscal officer presented bills totaling \$241,733.21 (\$202,513.28 payroll) since the last meeting to the trustees. The fiscal officer certified that there was sufficient money in the accounts to pay bills. _____ Debra Farley, Fiscal Officer. The trustees examined the payroll along with the following reports revenue status, appropriation status.

Darius Hardwick – Hardwick Tree Service: letting the Trustees know about his company and the service of tree trimming along township roads available if needed.

Tyler McNutt & Kyle Dodderer – Tyler is concerns w/neighbor of HeavenBound Airport. Mr. Dodderer, his legal counsel, explain that they feel that HeavenBound is not following their conditional use permit. There is no book of flights that has been required. There is a strict time frame of flight time and is not being followed. There was a complaint written in March to Mr. Fox, Zoning Inspector, and there has been no response. Mr. McNutt would like to have a response. He requests HeavenBound to follow their conditional use permit. Trustees explained that his personal flights are not restricted. Trustees informed Mr. McNutt that the Monroe Township BZA can't do anything w/permit. Mr. McNutt/Mr. Dodderer continued w/concerns of stopped logging flights in November due to taxing out of Liberty Township. Trustee Troy Hendren advised for any further communication needs to go through the Township's legal council at the L.C. Prosecutor's office. No more texting, communicating through e-mail.

Bill Paider – expressed his concern of the road condition of Blamer Rd. There is a 35mph sign down and the sign for Blamer Rd is also down. Trustees to look into event permits as well for Mr. Paider.

Mike Sileargy – Inquiring w/Trustees if a referendum had been turned in for the Piper property. Trustee have not received a referendum to date.

Christy Hawthorne – L.C. Soil & Water District – working w/L.C. Planning in helping residents. They would like to be advised on anything over 1 acre or more of ground being changed. This change will have to be reviewed.

Road Bids –

- ❖ 2012 F550 brakes locked up. Coughlin for repairs.

A motion was made by Troy Hendren and seconded by Joe Robertson to approve Small's Asphalt for the 2024 road repairs at \$302,527.86 along with the parking lot at the township complex.
